Wanted: Neighborhood Advisor for the local LGBTQ Community

SAGE Upstate seeks a Neighborhood Advisor who will reach out to support older LGBTQ people with resources, information on benefits, and strategies to stay strong and independent. Ideal candidates for this 30-hour/week position will have experience working with older adults and/or the LGBTQ community, and will be trained by the Onondaga County Department of Adult and Long Term Care Services.

SAGEVets on October 26



The next meeting of SAGEVets of Central and Western New York will feature Eric Alva, author of *Once a Marine, Coming Out Under Fire.*

All are welcome to this special presentation at the SAGEVets meeting on October 26 on Zoom (see log-in and call-in info on page 2). Our speaker, Eric Alva, was the first Marine seriously injured in the war in Iraq. He lost his leg from an explosive buried in the sand, and received a Purple Heart.

At the same time, under the Don't Ask Don't Tell, he was unable to serve openly as a gay man. Eric spoke out against this discriminatory law, which was repealed in 2011. He also wrote *Once A Marine: Coming Out Under Fire.* In the book, he shares his stories of battles on and off the battlefields. When he came out in 2007, he noted that he had been promoted and praised for his service, all the while having to keep his sexuality a secret.

SAGEVets is a statewide program that helps improve access to the VA and other medical services for LGBTQ older adults who are veterans of military service. Through a partnership between the national SAGE USA and SAGE Upstate, and with the support of funding from the NYS Legislature, this program now offers more services for Upstate veterans.

SAGE seeks candidates for Neighborhood Advisor Position

Would you or someone be interested in working to support older LGBTQ adults?

SAGE Upstate received a 3-year grant from Onondaga County to hire a Neighborhood Advisor to serve the older LG-BTQ community in CNY. We're looking for someone who will reach out to LGBTQ individuals aged 60 and older in need of services across the diverse communities of the county. The goals are to link those in need with resources, help people maintain a level of independence to remain in the community, and to share information with providers of aging and LGBT services. The position is 30 hours per week, but with the right candidates it could be split into two 15 hr/wk positions.

The Neighborhood Advisor will work one-on-one with older adults, build relationships with providers, and reach out to the community through programs and networking. The Department of Adult and Long Term Care Services will provide training for the person who is hired. Ideal candidates will have computer and database skills, a two year degree in a related field or four years experience, knowlege of local resources, and experience working with older adults, LGBT people, people of different races and different abilities. Who is eligible for COVID vaccine booster shots?

At the time of this printing, booster shots are available for those 65 or older who received the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine at least 6 months ago. Younger people with medical conditions or those who live or work in high risk settings may also be eligible. Studies show that protection from the original vaccine may decrease over time, so booster shots are recommended.
